On July 1, 2006, the Primary Adult Care Program was launched to provide basic health care services to people who make limited amounts of money each year.

ELIGIBILITY

- For people 19 years of age or older
- Can not be on Medicare or Medicaid
- Must meet income conditions of:
One person-----Monthly Income-----\$1,046
Two persons----Monthly Income-----\$1,408

BENEFITS

- Pharmacy
- Outpatient Mental Health Services
- Primary Care
- Family Planning Services
- Limited Dental Services
- Vision Care

SOME SERVICES NOT COVERED

- Inpatient Hospital Services
- Hospital Emergency Room Services
- Specialty Services
- Sterilization Procedures
