MOBILE VANS BRING FLU VACCINE TO NORTHERN WORCESTER

March 5, 2010, Snow Hill, Md. – The Worcester County Health Department continues to offer the H1N1 and seasonal flu vaccines in the community in an effort to reach those who may not have had the opportunity to be vaccinated. “Mobile vans have been an effective mechanism for bringing the flu vaccines to many community sites in Worcester County,” says Dr. Andrea Mathias, Deputy Health Officer.

The H1N1 flu vaccination is **free**. The charge for seasonal flu vaccine is \$15, which Medicare covers. The following locations will offer walk-in vaccination:

- Saturday, March 13th : **Home Depot**, Rt. 50, Berlin, Peninsula Regional Medical Center’s Wagner Wellness Van, 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. **(H1N1 flu vaccine only)**
- Thursday, March 18th: **Whaleyville Park**, 11723 Sheppard’s Crossing Rd., Whaleyville, Governor’s Wellmobile, 3:00 – 7:00 p.m.

There are also walk-in clinics for flu shots at each Health Department location throughout Worcester County. Seasonal and H1N1 flu shots are given in Snow Hill on Wednesdays, Pocomoke on Thursdays, and Berlin on Fridays from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

It’s not too late to get the flu, and it’s not too late to get vaccinated.
